The Northamptonshire Police Hate Crime Coordinator does a lot of work with the Community Engagement Officers and in partnership with other agencies like borough, county and district councils, voluntary and community organisations and schools.



This makes sure that all of the people dealing with Hate Crime give an excellent service to victims and witnesses of hate crime, they can spot it early on and make sure people follow the law.



The coordinator provides advice and information to partners and can support and represent people and communities affected by all forms of hate incidents. The Community Engagement Officers support the coordinator in working with ethnic minority groups and faith groups.

Working together in this way makes sure all communities are kept informed and have clear ways to communicate with the Police.

## Hate Crime and Incidents are:

Any crime or incident which is seen, by the victim or any other person, to be caused by anger or an opinion towards someone based one of these things:

- Disability
- Gender Identity
- Race, Ethnicity or Nationality
- Religion, Faith or Belief
- Sexual Orientation
- Something that makes someone appear different, like a different lifestyle, culture or looking different to other people.
