5. Please break down the monthly figures in question 4 by the recorded religion of the victim (where applicable)
6. Please break down the monthly figures in question 4 by the recorded ethnicity of the victim (where applicable)
7. Please break down the monthly figures in question 4 by the recorded ethnicity (not religion) of the accused offender (where known)
8. Please state whether, in its response to questions 1-7, the police force has classified anti-Semitic offences as racial hate crimes, religious hate crimes, or both

Response:

Search for all occurrences with either a NICL qualifier, SC Hate Crime or HO Group Description containing the word 'Racial' or 'Relig' between 1st January 2022 and 30th September 2025.

The dates below are when an occurrence was created on Northamptonshire Police's systems. This means that they reflect when the offence was recorded, rather than when the offence happened. There are many reasons why an offence may be reported in a different month or year to when it occurred.

There may be more than one victim and/or suspect per occurrence. If one person was involved in more than one occurrence, they will be counted for each. Equally, it is possible that no suspect was identified for a particular crime.

Question 9:

- a. Where applicable, a full address is recorded against each occurrence, as well as District/Ward/Postcode. There may not be an address linked to an occurrence, or the address may be the nearest identifiable location rather than where the occurrence actually took place. For example, if a crime occurred in the street outside a restaurant, the restaurant's address may be recorded as the location. There are also options for location type which may be recorded, for example "school", "street/road", "house".
- b. Outcome descriptions are recorded against each occurrence. The options are as follows:
 - 1: Charged
 - 1: Summoned/postal requisition
 - 1A: Alternate offence charged
 - 1A: Alternate offence summoned/postal requisition
 - 2: Youth caution
 - 2: Youth conditional caution
 - 2A: Alternate offence youth caution
 - 2A: Alternate offence youth conditional caution
 - 3: Adult caution
 - 3: Adult conditional caution
 - 3A: Alternate offence adult caution
 - 3A: Alternate offence adult conditional caution
 - 4: TIC (taken into consideration)
 - 5: Offender has died
 - 6: Penalty notice for disorder
 - 7: Cannabis warning
 - 7: Khat warning
 - 8: Community resolution
 - 8: Youth restorative disposal
 - 9: CPS - prosecution not in public interest
 - 10: Police - formal action not in public interest
 - 11: Named suspect below age of criminal responsibility
 - 12: Named suspect identified but is dead or too ill (physical or mental health) to prosecute
 - 13: Named suspect but victim/key witness deceased or too ill
 - 14: Victim declines/unable to support action to identify offender
 - 15: CPS - named suspect, victim supports but evidential difficulties
 - 15: Police - named suspect, victim supports but evidential difficulties
 - 16: Victim declines/withdraws support - named suspect identified
 - 17: Suspect identified but prosecution time limit expired
 - 18: Investigation complete no suspect identified
 - 20: Other body/agency has investigation primacy

Northamptonshire Police do not record convictions. This information is held by the Courts.

- c. Each occurrence has a start date as well as the date on which the occurrence was created in our systems. Occurrences may be recorded as having taken place within a date range. This could happen, for example, if a home burglary took place while the victim was on holiday, meaning the victim does not know on which day the occurrence took place.
- d. Details of offences are recorded in free text.

All of this information, if recorded, can be retrieved from Northamptonshire Police's systems. However, some information, such as details of offences, cannot be aggregated as it is free text rather than selected from given options. Any attempt at searching free text using keywords is also likely to produce inaccurate results due to the nature of keyword searches.

If requested, this information may be subject to exemptions under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The numerical data presented in this response is an unaudited snapshot of unpublished data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.

Northamptonshire Police systems are designed primarily for the management of individual cases and not for the production of statistical information for Freedom of Information responses.

The figures provided therefore are our best interpretation of relevance of data to your request, but you should be aware that the collation of figures for ad hoc requests may have limitations and this should be taken into account when the data is used.

If you decide to write an article/use the enclosed data, we ask you to take into consideration the factors highlighted in this document so as to not mislead members of the public or official bodies or misrepresent the relevance of the whole or any part of this disclosed material.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you are unhappy with how your request has been handled or you do not think the decision is correct, you have the right to require the Northamptonshire Police to review their decision.

Prior to lodging a formal appeal you are welcome and encouraged to discuss the decision with the case officer that dealt with your request.

Ask to have the decision looked at again

The quickest and easiest way to have the decision looked at again is to telephone the case officer that is nominated at the end of your decision letter. That person will be able to discuss the decision, explain any issues and assist with any problems.

Appeal

If you are dissatisfied with the handling procedures or the decision that Northamptonshire Police have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) regarding access to information, you can lodge an appeal with the Northamptonshire Police to have the decision reviewed.

The Information Commissioner

After lodging an appeal with the Northamptonshire Police, if you are still dissatisfied with the decision, you may make an application to the Information Commissioner for a decision on whether the request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of the Act.
