How many police officers who are serving with your force have you been made aware, that either there son or daughter has been arrested by your force and is waiting to appear in court

NB Son or daughter is to be taken to mean biological parents, adoptive parents, foster parents or for any person they are acting in loco parentis.

Response:

Searches were conducted within Northamptonshire Police to locate the information requested and I can now confirm that Northamptonshire Police has not arrested either the son or daughter of a serving Northamptonshire Police Officer between the identified dates.
