

**Request:**

1. Between April 1st and July 1st 2020, **how many** domestic abuse cases received by your force were:
  - (a) reported BY MEN where the alleged perpetrator is FEMALE
  - (b) reported BY MEN where the alleged perpetrator is MALE
  - (c) reported by WOMEN where the alleged perpetrator is MALE.
  - (d) reported by WOMEN where the alleged perpetrator is FEMALE.
2. Between April 1st and July 1st 2020, how many MALE arrests were made on suspicion of domestic abuse of a FEMALE?
3. Between April 1st and July 1st 2020, how many MALE arrests were made on suspicion of domestic abuse of a MALE?
4. Between April 1st and July 1st 2020, how many FEMALE arrests were made on suspicion of domestic abuse of a MALE?
5. Between April 1st and July 1st 2020 how many FEMALE arrests were made on suspicion of domestic abuse of a FEMALE?

**Response:**

To note:

- All Incidents have been searched where the NSIR qualifier of 'Domestic related' has been selected
- All crime occurrences have been searched where the NICL qualifier of 'domestic abuse' has been selected
- Not all crimes have to be recorded from incidents and multiple crimes can be recorded from one incident
- The number of Arrests are where an Arrest record is attached to the Occurrence
