

**Request:**

The number of hate crimes reported where the victim was identified as Gypsy, Roma or Traveller. If possible, I would also like this information broken down by the ethnic group of the victim i.e. Gypsy, Roma or Traveller. I would like this information for the last five years, broken down by year i.e. 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.

**Response:**

This data is based on self-defined ethnicity which is the choice of the person involved, and can be refused.

Data has been searched where there is a pattern match for ethnicity "W3" to identify Traveller-Gypsy for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016-28<sup>th</sup> July 2020:

Due to the different methods of recording information across 43 forces, a specific response from one constabulary should not be seen as an indication of what information could be supplied (within cost) by another.
